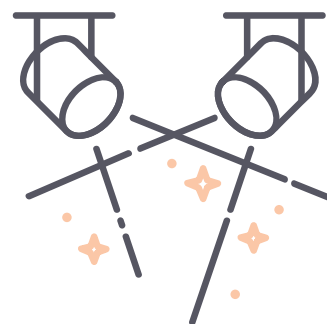

WELCOME TO OUR SCHOOLS

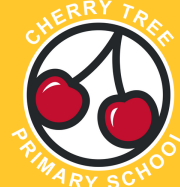
This week we went live with the brand new admissions areas of our school websites. Alongside this is an easy to navigate landing page over the school homepage to showcase our schools and what we have to offer.

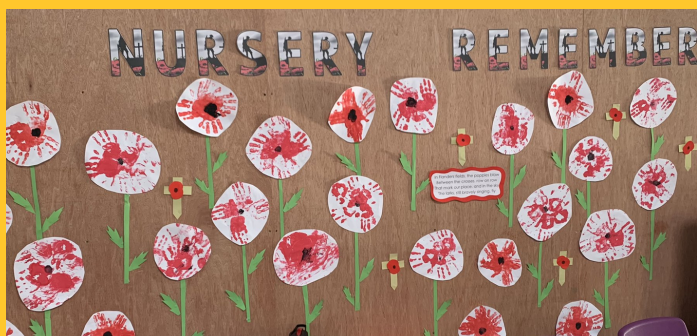
ODD SOCKS DAY FOR ANTI BULLYING WEEK
