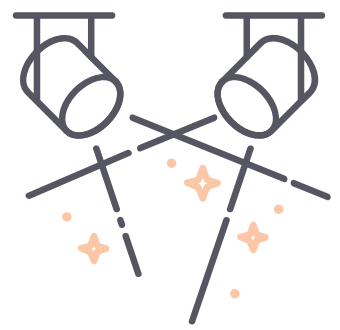


# INCLUSIVE | MULTI ACADEMY TRUST IN THE SPOTLIGHT

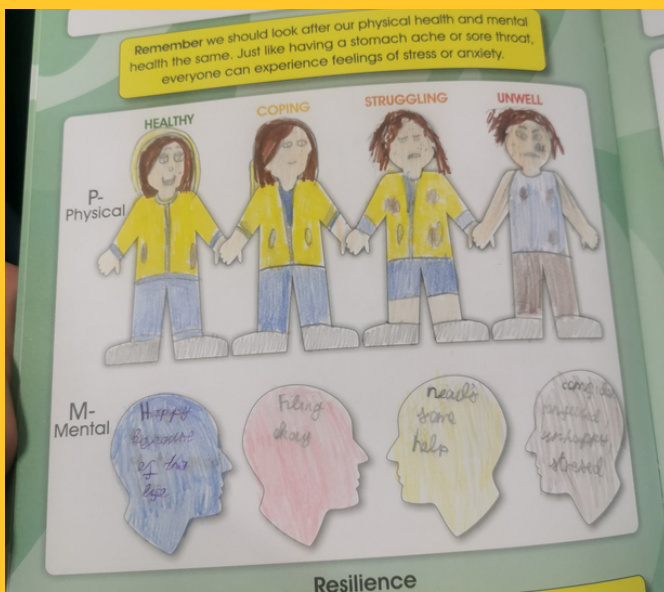
## WELCOME

## VISIT FROM THE MAYOR

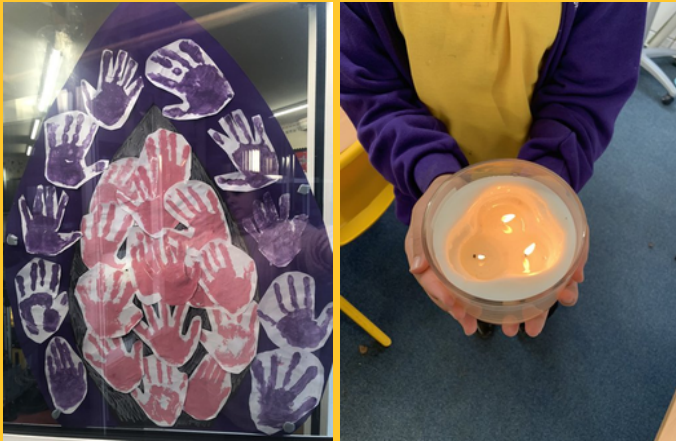
