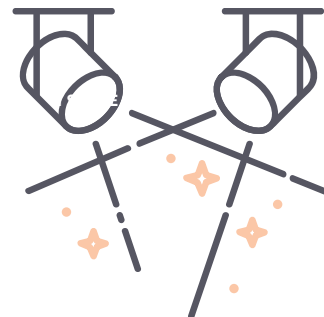

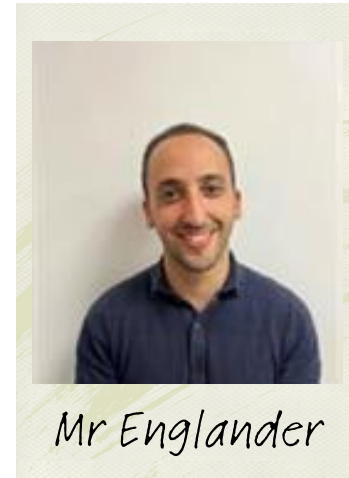

EARLY YEARS MURAL

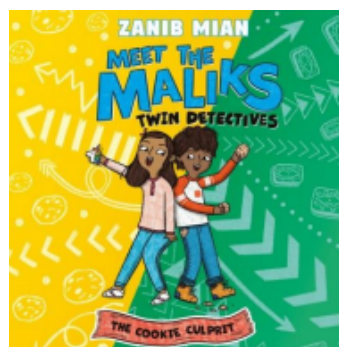
