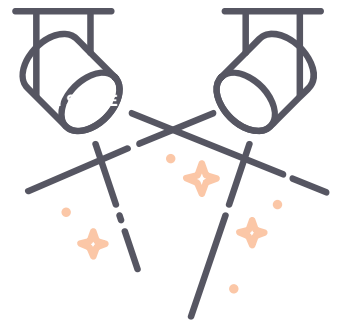

INTERNATIONAL PICNIC

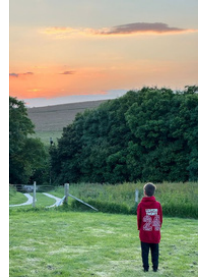
Cherry Tree celebrated the last day of the Summer 1 term with an international picnic. This picnic was an opportunity to celebrate the diversity of cultures in our school.

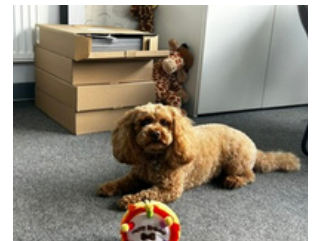
OUTDOOR FESTIVAL

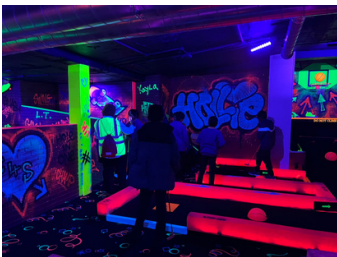
INTERNATIONAL DAY
